17 teachers have been awarded with “Best Teacher” award in a ceremony organized by NCHD on 14<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2010 to recognize the contributions of teachers to improve quality of education and literacy rate in the country.

The awards for the best institutions were given to the principals of the respective institutions; while the award for best management was received by Dr. Shaheen Khan, D.D Federal Directorate of Education, Dr. Tanvir Kiyani, Director Training Federal Directorate of Education, and Prof. Shahista Pirzada, Principal Islamabad College for Girls, F-6/2.
