

NCHD to Rehabilitate Women through Skill-based Literacy

National Commission for Human Development has adopted the plan to rehabilitate women camped in various Flood Relief Camps all over Pakistan through Skill-based literacy programs. 750 women will immediately be enrolled for this program.

A meeting was also arranged a few days earlier with a donor, Mrs. Naeema Tareen & Mrs. Javeed Iqbal, and a skill center was also established for the women to jump-start the project. 15 sewing machines were donated by the donors and their friends. Both donors also provided the affected ladies with cloth.



Sewing machines used by these ladies shall also be donated to them. These sewn clothes will be distributed at three different locations to help the flood affected people.
