Today I met with Mr. Peer Bux Chajro DDO Coordination district dadu. I discussed with him the current flood situation in district dadu. He said that dadu is continuously receiving flood water and the peak flood will reach here up to 10 th August now the water discharge is approximately 300,000 cusecs. He said that we are expecting maximum flow of water up to 600,000 cusecs here in the kacha areas of dadu.
		26 camps are occupied in dadu talka and one in Mehar Talka with the flood affected. Total No of peoples in camps are 2,102. Rest of the peoples has preferred to live with their relatives because here is strong cast system and persons of one cast are not willing to stay with other casts. The total area came under water is 77,140 acres out of which 45140 acres in dadu talka and 32,000 acres in Mehar Talka. They have not received yet the actual No of HHs destroyed and damagedin the flood, because survey work will start after receding of the water. The breakup of

population to be disturbed is Talka dadu 77,140 and talka Mehar 45,140.

Yesterday I also visited some villages of talka dadu Mohd Bux Korai, Master Naban Jatoi met with villagers and persuade them to shift timely in packa area in this way they can save their precious assets like livestock and other house hold appliances. Our MCs also have established information desks in camps and also playing the role of facilitators to flood affected peoples.

Honorable Dr. Azra Fazal Pechuho (Sister of President of Pakistan) visited Madd Bund in Taluka Sakrand along with DCO, DPO, EDO Education, EDO Health, EDO Revenue & CDD, DGM-NCHD, EDO Works & Services, DO Revenue, media representatives, other officials and local political leaders. She visited Madd Bund site and observed the current water increased situation in Indus River. The Ex. Engineer Irrigation briefed them that irrigation department has taken special measurement to control the high flood. He said that we are hopeful to control the critical situation without having incredible losses. They said that coming 2 to 3 days are

critical and irrigation department team is monitoring every water flow movement and bund. Irrigation department staff members are alert. She visited also medical facilitation unit at Madd Bund. DGM informed to Dr. Azra Fazul that NCHD team is also working with rapid force committee, education and health department. appreciated the NCHD team. NCHD team members MCs and Volunteers wearing the NCHD jackets and badges were presents during the visit. Then she visited the Majeed keerio relief camp.

Taluka Team of Sakrand has evacuated 71 households from village Ali Murad Baroch and Mir Muhammad Lakho UC Gohram Mari to safe areas. 575 patients have been diagnosed cases of Malaria due to rainy season by Malaria control program team. It is observed that malaria cases are more then diseases. 376 domestic animals vaccinated by animal husbandry department in Taluka Sakrand. Team has met with SDO Irrigation for current water flow situation. SDO informed that today peak value of water at mangli 2 lac 75 thousands cusses. MCs and volunteers are working at medical facilitation units for help and assistance of health department and effected peoples.

Taluka Team Kazi Ahmed and DDO Revenue Chairman Rapid Relief Committee with his team are working together in katcha areas of Taluka. Team has evacuated 38 persons at Bachalpur relief camp. 120 patients have received medicines from Bachalpur medical facilitation unit. There is shortage of water in relief camps. Team have contacted with DD Revenue for this connection. 7 vokunteers are there in relief camps. Please find here also attached DSR report and daily activity report.
